How to write

LETTER OF **RECOMMENDATION**

The Letter

A letter of Recommendation is a tool to convince the admission officer that you are a worthy candidate and that your qualification and dedication are well suited to the course. It provides the admission committee with substantial information to create a positive impact.

It is a distant interview of sorts wherein the admission officer relies on the recommendation of an expert which successfully establishes you as a perfect applicant. While the transcripts establish the academic criteria, the Recommendation letter allows the officer insight into your personality and passion for the course.

Choose the referee wisely since this document has a substantial effect on the decision of the admissions officer. It may be obtained from a person who has known you in an academic or a professional capacity and can provide substantial details about your achievements.

Remember

The letter may be obtained from the Professor/Head of Department/Principal.

Ensure that the personal and academic achievements and performances are highlighted

It should be a realistic assessment of the students - substantiating the analytical capacity and the leadership qualities with healthy communication skills.

Structure

Opening

Establish the relationship between the students and the referee. Include the time period of knowing the student

Body

Include the Characteristics of the students that are relevant to the course Include knowledge of the subject that the student has gained during studying with

you. Incorporate areas of strength and any awards/recognition that the student has

Share personal experience with the student and any specific responsibilities that were effectively completed Emphasize the ability of the student to work in a team, Leadership qualities, and Motivation factor

Ensure that the student is seen as dedicated, hardworking and goal-oriented with qualities to deal with challenges.

Summarise

Specifically, recommend the student as a GOOD FIT for the university.

Ascertain that the student, as well as the university, would gain from the presence of the student at the university.

It's Important

Ensure that the Recommendation Letter highlights the strengths and achievements of the student

The document should be a fair account with distinctions made between opinions and facts

The letter should be more than just a character certificate. it should reflect the strengths of the student.

It should reinforce that the student would be a beneficial student for the university.

How to write

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Before you begin

Do not mention the name of the university if you are applying through the common application

Check the requisites for the application

Make a draft with all the points you wish to include.

Include

Interest in the course

Experience related to the field

Reason for choosing the course

Course module that you have studied previously

Career Goals and how this course is relevant

Relevant extra-curricular Activities

Remember

It can be up to 4,000 characters of 47 lines of text (including spaces and blank lines)

Do not copy - if plagiarism is detected, it would jeopardise your application

Check grammar, spelling and punctuation

Avoid

Being over the top: Do not write stories about heroism or be pretentious

Amusing: It is a serious document, keep it interesting yet serious

Controversial Views: Do not indulge in any debate or views that can be controversial

Quotes: Admission officers want to know what you think so do not state quotes as punch lines

Establish yourself as a Worthy Candidate

Structure the statement to establish you are a worthy candidate.

Outline your skills and achievements that would enable you to complete the course.

Convey your work experience or voluntary work that has developed skills essential for your course.

Communicate your enthusiasm and passion for the subject.

Explain the advantage of the chosen country over the home country to pursue the course.

Express the international community's advantage.

Introduction

Start the statement with an Opening sentence that ENCOURAGES the reader to read on.

Structure

Structure the statement in the order that is most relevant to what the university and colleges are looking for. ESTABLISH your reasons to choose the course.

Conclusion

Reinforce your commitment, enthusiasm and skills that makes you a WORTHY CANDIDATE.

UK STUDENT VISA (TIER 4)

Student Visa can be applied for if you:

1. Have been offered a place on a course by a licensed student sponsor

2. Can speak, read, write and understand English

3. Have enough money to support yourself and pay for

4. Have consent from your parents if you're 16 or 17

4. Meet the other eligibility requirement

5. Are from a country that's not in the European Economic Area (EEA) or Switzerland



1. CONFIRMATION OF ACCEPTANCE

The university sends a unique CAS number Visa can be applied only with the CAS number

2. DOCUMENTS

Carefully collect and prepare the list of documents required

3. APPLICATION

Apply for General Student Visa Tier 4 Apply, pay the fee and submit the form online

4. HEALTH **SURCHARGE**

You will also have to pay a healthcare surcharge (called the 'immigration health surcharge' or IHS) in addition to your visa fee

5. BIOMETRICS

As part of the application process you must have your photograph and your fingerprints taken. This is known as your biometrics

6. CREDIBILITY CHECK

You may be asked to attend a credibility interview as part of the application process. Interviews are normally carried out by a secure telecommunications system or face-face at Home Office centres across the UK

7. SUBMISSION

Book an appointment online Visa Application

You must submit all documents in person






